

**FINAL RITES FOR  
ALBERT YATES**

Albert F. Yates, 75, of Queen City, died Thursday morning in a Kirksville hospital following an illness of one year.

Funeral services were held at St. John's Lutheran Church Sunday afternoon, November 18, 1962, at 2:30 o'clock, conducted by the Rev. John T. Carter, pastor of the Methodist Church of Greentop. Burial was in the Germania Cemetery of Schuyler County. The body lay in state at the Dee Riley Funeral home until 12:00 o'clock Sunday November 18, at which time it was taken to the church.

Mr. Yates was the son of Hiram and Elizabeth (Smith) Yates and was born December 6, 1886, in Queen City. He was married to Bertha Bergman in 1911, and to this marriage five children were born. Mrs. Bergman died in 1931. He was married to Kathryn (Daugherty) Bland Feburary 17, 1943, in Queen City.

He is survived by his wife; one daughter, Mrs. Ralph (Thelma) Banner of Kirksville; two sons, Noel Yates of Queen City, and Ross Yates of Columbus Junction, Ia., one step-daughter, Mrs. Wallace (Wilma) Fry of Talco, Texas, two step-sons, Oran Bland and J. Mr. Yates was preceded in death by his parents; two daughters; one brother; one grandson and one step grandson.
