

# Applying technology to tackle gender based violence in Trinidad and Tobago

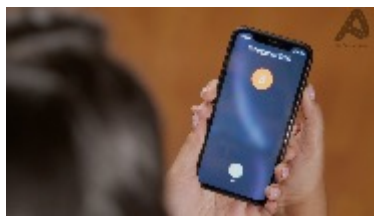
## Our Story

The Andrea Project was birthed from the outcry of the nation against an increased rate of Gender-Based Violence. Collectively we are a group of men and women from diverse backgrounds united in hope and belief that together a few people could make a huge impact on a social problem.

## The “Help Save a Life” Series

The Andrea Project recently launched a bilingual “Help Save a Life” video series which trains people on how to use technology at their fingertips which could save their lives in an emergency.

The videos are available on all major social media platforms and YouTube, and were supported by the UNDP, UN Women and Trinity Exploration.



## What's next for The Andrea Project

- 1** Develop a **database of gender-based violence incidents by using human-augmented machine learning** to build a proprietary tool that scrapes publicly available news sources. The database can be used by researchers, the general public and our own organisation to understand trends in GBV and plan interventions accordingly.
- 2** Build a **chatbot to support victims of GBV**. Our chatbot will follow an agreed referral pathway and integrate with other publicly available support services.
- 3** Support other established GBV NGOs in the digital space and develop a **digital campaign that builds awareness of the Domestic Violence Act**.
