## **Jubilees Chapter 6:1-13**

1 On the Head of the third Chodesh he went out of the ark, and built an altar on that mountain.

2 And he made atonement for the earth, and took a kid and made atonement by its blood for all the guilt of the earth; for every thing that had been on it had been destroyed, except those that were in the ark with Noah.

3 He placed the fat of it on the altar, and he took an ox, and a goat, and a sheep and kids, and salt, and a turtle-dove, and the young of a dove, and placed a burnt sacrifice on the altar, and poured on it an offering mingled with oil, and sprinkled wine and sprinkled frankincense over everything, and caused a good and pleasing odor to arise, acceptable before Yah.

4 And Yah smelled the good and pleasing odor, and He made a covenant with Noah that there should not be any more floods to destroy the earth; that all the days of the earth seed-time and harvest should never cease; cold and heat, and summer and winter, and day and night should not change their order, nor cease forever.

5 “Increase and multiply on the earth, and become many, and be a blessing on it. I will inspire the fear of you and the dread of you in everything that is on earth and in the sea.

6 Look, I have given you all beasts, and all winged things, and everything that moves on the earth, and the fish in the waters, and all things for food; as the green herbs, I have given you all things to eat.

7 But you shall not eat anything live or with blood in it, for the life of all flesh is in the blood, or your blood of your lives will be required. At the hand of every man, at the hand of every beast will I require the blood of man.

8 Whoever sheds man’s blood by man shall his blood be shed, for in the image of Elohim He made man.

9 Increase, and multiply on the earth.”

10 Noah and his sons swore that they would not eat any blood that was in any flesh, and he made a covenant before Yah Elohim forever throughout all the generations of the earth in this Chodesh.

11 Because of this He spoke to you that you should make a covenant with the children of Israel with an oath. In this Chodesh, on the mountain you should sprinkle blood on them because of all the words of the covenant, which Yah made with them forever.

12 This testimony is written concerning you that you should observe it continually, so that you should not eat on any day any blood of beasts or birds or cattle during all the days of the earth, and the man who eats the blood of beast or of cattle or of birds during all the days of the earth, he and his offspring shall be rooted out of the land.

13 And you will command the children of Israel to eat no blood, so that their names and their offspring may be before Yah our Elohim continually.



### Jubilees Chapter 6:14-23

14 There is no limit of days, for this law. It is forever. They shall observe it throughout their generations, so that they may continue supplicating on your behalf with blood before the altar; every day and at the time of morning and evening they shall seek forgiveness on your behalf perpetually before Yah that they may keep it and not be rooted out.

15 And He gave to Noah and his sons a sign that there should not again be a flood on the earth.

16 He set His bow (**a rainbow**) in the cloud as a sign of the eternal covenant that there should never again be a flood on the earth to destroy it for all the days of the earth.

17 For this reason it is ordained **and written on the heavenly tablets**, that they should celebrate the feast of weeks in this Chodesh once a year, **to renew the covenant every year**.

18 This whole festival was celebrated in heaven from the day of creation until the days of Noah, which were twenty-six jubilees and five weeks of years. Noah and his sons observed it for seven jubilees and one week of years, until the day of Noah's death. **From the day of Noah's death his sons did away with it until the days of Abraham**, and they ate blood.

19 But **Abraham observed it, and Isaac and Jacob and his children observed it** up to your days, and in your days the children of Israel forgot it until you celebrated it anew on this mountain.

20 Command the children of Israel to observe this festival in all their generations for a commandment to them, one day in the year in this Chodesh they shall celebrate the festival.

21 For it is the feast of weeks and the feast of first-fruits, **this feast is twofold and of a double nature**, according to what is written and engraved concerning it, celebrate it.

22 For I have written in the book of the first law, in that which I have written for you, that you should celebrate it in its season, one day in the year, and I explained to you its sacrifices that the children of Israel should remember and should celebrate it throughout their generations in this Chodesh, the same day in every year.

23 **In the Heads, (1<sup>st</sup> Days) of the first, and the fourth, and the seventh, and the tenth Chodeshi, (Months) are the days of remembrance, and the days of the seasons in the four divisions of the year** These are written and ordained as a testimony forever.

### **Jubilees Chapter 6:24-31**

24 Noah ordained them for himself as feasts for the generations forever, so that they have become a memorial to him.

25 On the Head of the **first Chodesh** he was told to make for himself an ark, and on that day the earth was dry and he saw from the opened ark, the earth. On the Head of the **fourth Chodesh** the mouths of the depths of the bottomless pit beneath were closed.

26 On the Head of the **seventh Chodesh** all the mouths of the abysses of the earth were opened, and the waters began to descend into them.

27 On the Head of the **tenth Chodesh** the tops of the mountains were seen, and Noah was glad.

28 Because of this he ordained them for himself as feasts for a memorial forever, and thus are they ordained.

29 **And they placed them on the heavenly tablets, each had thirteen weeks;** from one to another passed their memorial, from the first to the second, and from the second to the third, and from the third to the fourth.

30 All the days of the commandment will be two and fifty weeks of days, and these will make the entire year complete.

**Thus it is engraved and ordained on the heavenly tablets.**

31 And there is no neglecting this commandment for a single year or from year to year.

## Jubilees Chapter 6:32-38

32 Command you the children of Israel that they observe the years according to this counting, **three hundred and sixty-four days**, and these will constitute a complete year, and they will not disturb its time from its days and from its feasts; for every thing will fall out in them according to their testimony, and they will not leave out any day nor disturb any feasts.

33 **But if they neglect and do not observe them according to His commandment, then they will disturb all their seasons and the years will be dislodged from this order, and they will neglect their established rules.**

34 **And all the children of Israel will forget and will not find the path of the years, and will forget the new Chodeshim, and seasons, and sabbaths and they will wrongly determine all the order of the years.**

35 For I know and from now on will I declare it to you, and it is not of my own devising; **for the book lies written in the presence of me, and on the heavenly tablets the division of days is ordained**, or **they forget the feasts of the covenant and walk according to the feasts of the Gentiles after their error and after their ignorance.**

36 **For there will be those who will assuredly make observations of the moon and how it disturbs the seasons and comes in from year to year ten days too soon.**

37 **For this reason the years will come upon them when they disturb (misinterpret) the order, and make an abominable day the day of testimony, and an unclean day a feast day, and they will confound all the days, the pure with the unclean, and the unclean day with the pure; for they will go wrong as to the Chodeshim and sabbaths and feasts and jubilees.**

38 For this reason I command and testify to you that you may testify to them; for after your death your children will disturb them, so that they will not make the year three hundred and sixty-four days only, and for this reason they will go wrong as to the new Chodeshim and seasons and sabbaths and festivals, and they will eat all kinds of blood with all kinds of flesh.

14 And Elohim said, Let there be lights in the firmament of the heaven to divide the day from the night; and let them be for signs, and for seasons, and for days, and years: 15 And let them be for lights in the firmament of the heaven to give light upon the earth: and it was so. 16 And Elohim made two great lights; the greater light to rule the day, and the lesser light to rule the night: he made the stars also. 17 And Elohim set them in the firmament of the heaven to give light upon the earth, 18 And to rule over the day and over the night, and to divide the light from the darkness: and Elohim saw that it was good. 19 And there was evening and there was morning, the fourth day.

## **Origin of the day of atonement**

**Jubilee 34:10-19**

**10 And in the seventh year of this week he sent Joseph to learn about the welfare of his brothers from his house to the land of Shechem, and he found them in the land of Dothan.**

**11 And they dealt treacherously with him, and formed a plot against him to slay him, but changing their minds, they sold him to Ishmaelite**

**merchants, and they brought him down into Egypt, and they sold him to Potiphar, the eunuch of Pharaoh, the chief of the cooks, priest of the city of Elew.**

**12 And the sons of Jacob slaughtered a kid, and dipped the coat of Joseph in the blood, and sent (it) to Jacob their father on the tenth of the seventh Chodesh.**

**13 And he mourned all that night, for they had brought it to him in the evening, and he became feverish with mourning for his death, and he said: "An evil beast hath devoured Joseph"; and all the members of his house [mourned with him that day, and they] were grieving and mourning with him all that day.**

**14 And his sons and his daughter rose up to comfort him, but he refused to be comforted for his son.**

**15 And on that day Bilhah heard that Joseph had perished, and she died mourning him, and she was living in Qafratef and Dinah also, his daughter, died after Joseph had perished. And there came these three mournings upon Israel in one Chodesh.**

**16 And they buried Bilhah over against the tomb of Rachel, and Dinah also, his daughter, they buried there.**

**17 And he mourned for Joseph one year, and did not cease, for he said "Let me go down to the grave mourning for my son."**

**18 For this reason it is ordained for the children of Israel that they should afflict themselves on the tenth of the seventh Chodesh -- on the day that the news which made him weep for Joseph came to Jacob his father -- that they should make atonement for themselves thereon with a young goat on the tenth of the seventh Chodesh, once a year, for their sins; for they had grieved the affection of their father regarding Joseph his son.**

**19 And this day hath been ordained that they should grieve thereon for their sins, and for all their transgressions and for all their errors, so that they might cleanse themselves on that day once a year.**

## **Jubilee 2:8**

**8 And on the fourth day He **created** the **sun** and the moon and the stars, and set them in the firmament of the heaven,  
to give light upon all the earth, and  
to rule over the day and the night, and  
divide the light from the darkness.**

## Jubilee 2:9

9 And Elohim **appointed** the **sun**  
to be a **great sign**  
on the earth  
for **days** and

The 5th chodesh starts on Yom Sheshe.

The 8th chodesh starts on Yom Sheshe.

The 11th chodesh starts on Yom Sheshe.

The 3rd chodesh starts on Yom Rashon, (1st day).

The 6th chodesh starts on Yom Rashon.

The 9th chodesh starts on Yom Rashon.

The 12th chodesh starts on Yom Rashon.

The number of Yomi for each of the 4 seasons:

1st chodesh has 30 Yomi, (days / ימי).

Springs Season

2nd chodesh has 30 Yomi.

3rd chodesh has 31 Yomi.

4th chodesh has 30 Yomi.

Summer Season

5th chodesh has 30 Yomi.

6th chodesh has 31 Yomi.

7th chodesh has 30 Yomi.

Fall Season

8th chodesh has 30 Yomi.

9th chodesh has 31 Yomi.

10th chodesh has 30 Yomi.

Winter Season

11th chodesh has 30 Yomi.

12th chodesh has 31 Yomi.

Equals 364 Yomi.

1st Enoch Ch 72: 1-4

1 The Book of the courses of the luminaries of the heaven, the relations of each, according to their classes, their dominion and their seasons, according to their names and places of origin, and according to their Chodeshi, which Uriel, the holy angel, who was with me, who is their guide, showed men and he showed me all their laws exactly as they are, and how it is with regard to all the years of the world and unto eternity, till the new creation is accomplished which dureth till eternity.

2 And this is the first law of the luminaries: the luminary the Sun has its rising in the eastern portals of the heaven, and its setting in the western portals of the heaven.

3 And I saw six portals in which the sun rises, and six portals in which the sun sets: and the moon rises and sets in these portals, and the leaders of the stars and those whom they lead: six in the east and six in the west, and all following each other in accurately corresponding order: also many windows to the right and left of these portals.

4 And first there goes forth the great luminary, named the Sun, and his circumference is like the circumference of the heaven, and he is quite filled with illumination and heating fire.

These time parameters are accurate from the 12 Islands North of the Philippines

1st Enoch Ch 72: 5-10

5 The chariot on which he ascends, the wind drives, and the sun goes down from the heaven and returns through the north in order to reach the east, and is so guided that he comes to the appropriate portal and shines in the face of the heaven.

**6 In this way he rises in the first Chodesh in the great portal, which is the fourth.**

7 And in that fourth portal from which the sun rises in the first Chodesh are twelve window-openings, from which proceed a flame when they are opened in their season.

8 When the sun rises in the heaven, he comes forth through that fourth portal **thirty mornings** in succession, and sets accurately in the fourth portal in the west of the heaven.

9 And during this period the day becomes daily longer and the night nightly shorter to the thirtieth morning.

10 On that day the day is longer than the night by a ninth part, and the day amounts exactly to ten parts and the night to eight parts.

These time parameters are accurate from the 12 Islands North of the Philippines

1st Enoch Ch 72: 11-16

11 And the sun rises from that portal, and sets in the fourth and returns to the fifth portal of the east thirty mornings, and rises from it and sets in the fifth portal.

12 And then the day becomes longer by two parts, and amounts to eleven parts, and the night becomes shorter and amounts to seven parts.

13 And it returns to the east and enters into the sixth portal one and **thirty mornings on account of its sign.**

14 On that day the day becomes longer than the night, and the day becomes double the night and the day becomes twelve parts, and the night is shortened and becomes six parts.

15 And the sun mounts up to make the day shorter and the night longer, and the sun returns to the east and enters into the sixth portal, and rises from it and sets **thirty mornings.**

16 And when thirty mornings are accomplished, the day decreases by exactly one part, and becomes eleven parts, and the night seven.

These time parameters are accurate from the 12 Islands North of the Philippines

1st Enoch Ch 72: 17-22

17 And the sun goes forth from that sixth portal in the west, and goes to the east and rises in the fifth portal for **thirty mornings** and sets in the west again in the fifth western portal.

18 On that day the day decreases by two parts, and amounts to ten parts, and the night to eights parts.

19 And the sun goes forth from that fifth portal and sets in the fifth portal and sets in the fifth portal of the west, and rises in the fourth portal for **one and thirty mornings** on account of its sign, and sets in the west.

20 On that day the day is equalized with the night, and the night amounts to nine parts and the day to nine parts and the day to nine parts.

21 And the sun rises from that portal and sets in the west, and returns to the east and rises **thirty mornings** in the third portal and sets in the west in the third portal.

22 And on that day the night becomes longer than the day, and night amounts exactly to ten parts.

These time parameters are accurate from the 12 Islands North of the Philippines

1st Enoch Ch 72: 23-28

23 And the sun rises from that third portal and sets in the third portal in the west and returns to the east, and for **thirty mornings** rises in the second portal in the east, and in like manner sets in the second portal in the west of the heaven.

24 And on that day the night amounts to eleven parts and the day to seven parts.

25 And the sun rises on that day from that second portal and sets in the west in the second portal, and returns to the east into the first portal for **one and thirty mornings**, and sets in the first portal in the west of the heaven.

26 And on that day the night becomes longer and amounts to the double of the day: and the night amounts exactly to twelve parts and the day to six.

27 And the sun has traversed the divisions of his orbit and turns again on those divisions of his orbit, and enters that portal **thirty mornings** and sets also in the west opposite to it.

28 And on that night has the night decreased in length by a ninth part, and the night has become eleven parts and the day seven parts.

These time parameters are accurate from the 12 Islands North of the Philippines

1st Enoch Ch 72: 29-35

29 And the sun has returned and entered into the second portal in the east, and returns on those his divisions of his orbit for thirty mornings, rising and setting.

30 And on that day the night decreases in length, and the night amounts to ten parts and the day to eight.

31 And on that day the sun rises from that portal, and sets in the west, and returns to the east, and rises in the third portal for **one and thirty mornings**, and sets in the west of the heaven.

32 On that day the night decreases and amounts to nine parts, and the day to nine parts, and the night is equal to the day and the year is exactly as to its **days three hundred and sixty-four**.

33 And the length of the day and of the night, and the shortness of the day and of the night arise---through the course of the sun these distinctions are made.

34 So it comes that its course becomes daily longer and its course nightly shorter.

35 **And this is the law and the course of the sun**, and his return as often as he returns sixty times and rises, the great luminary which is named the Sun, for ever and ever.



**1** Remember the commandment which Yahuah commanded thee concerning the passover, that thou shouldst celebrate it in its season on the **fourteenth of the first month**, that thou shouldst kill it before it is evening, and **that they should eat it by night on the evening of the fifteenth from the time of the setting of the sun.**

**2** For on this night -- the beginning of the festival and the beginning of the joy -- ye were eating the passover in Egypt, when all the powers of Mastêmâ had been let loose to slay all the first-born in the land of Egypt, from the firstborn of Pharaoh to the first-born of the captive maidservant in the mill, and to the cattle.

**3** And this is the sign which Yahuah gave them: Into every house on the lintels of which they saw the blood of a lamb of the first year, into (that) house they should not enter to slay, but should pass by (it), that all those should be saved that were in the house because the sign of the blood was on its lintels.

**4** And the powers of Yahuah did everything according as Yahuah commanded them, and they passed by all the children of Israel, and the plague came not upon them to destroy from amongst them any soul either of cattle, or man, or dog.

**5** And the plague was very grievous in Egypt, and there was no house in Egypt where there was not one dead, and weeping and lamentation.

**6** And all Israel was eating the flesh of the paschal lamb, and drinking the wine, and was lauding and blessing, and giving thanks to the Yahuah Elohim of their fathers, and was ready to go forth from under the yoke of Egypt; and from the evil bondage.

**7** And remember thou this day all the days of thy life, and observe it from year to year all the days of thy life, once a year, on its day, according to all the law thereof, and **do not adjourn (it)** from day to day, or from Chodesh to Chodesh.

**8** For it is an eternal ordinance, and engraven on the heavenly tables regarding all the children of Israel that they should observe it every year on its day once a year, throughout all their generations; and there is no limit of days, for this is ordained for ever.

**9** And the man who is free from uncleanness, and doth not come to observe it on occasion of its day, so as to bring an acceptable offering before Yahuah, and to eat and to drink before Yahuah on the day of its festival, **that man who is clean and close at hand will be cut off**; because he offered not the oblation of Yahuah in its appointed season, he will take the guilt upon himself.

**10** Let the children of Israel come and observe the passover on the day of its fixed time, on the fourteenth day of the first Chodesh, between the evenings, from the third part of the day to the third part of the night, **for two portions of the day are given to the light**, and a third part to the evening.



**11** That is that which Yahuah commanded thee that thou shouldst observe it between the evenings.

**12** And it is not permissible to slay it during any period of the light, **but during the period bordering on the evening**, and let them eat it at the time of the evening until the third part of the night, and whatever is leftover of all its flesh from the third part of the night and onwards, let them burn it with fire.

## 1 Enoch 75: 1-2

1 And the leaders of the heads of the thousands,  
who are placed over the whole creation and  
over all the stars have also to do with the four intercalary days,  
being inseparable from their office,  
according to the reckoning of the year, and  
these render service on the four days which are not reckoned in the  
reckoning of the year.

2 And owing to them men go wrong therein,  
for those luminaries truly render service on the world-stations,  
one in the first portal,  
one in the third portal of the heaven,  
one in the fourth portal, and  
one in the sixth portal, and

**the exactness of the year is accomplished through its  
 separate three hundred and sixty-four stations. **

1 Enoch 75: 2b

 the exactness of the year is accomplished through its separate three hundred and sixty-four stations. 

75: 2b Reveals that each 364 day year is Separate.

Each 364 day year is Set-Apart with the Spring Equinox.  
The Spring Equinox is where the following overplus is located:

Enoch 74: 11-12

11 And the overplus of the sun and of the stars amounts to **six days**:


**in 5 years 6 days**: and

the moon falls behind the sun and stars to the number of 30 days.

12 And the  sun and the stars  bring in all the years exactly,  
**so that they do not advance or delay their position by a single day** unto  
eternity; but complete the years with perfect justice in 364 days.

Enoch 82: 5

Owing to them **men shall be at fault and not reckon them in the whole reckoning of the year**: yea, men shall be at fault, and not recognize them accurately.

1) Here we see the affirmation of the 4 intercalary days that divide each season are actually infiltrated into the calendar,

30 days per 12 Chodesim = 360 days + 4 Extra days = 364 days Total

The Abominable day of the Spring Equinox is not counted in the reckoning of the year, because it Sets-Apart the 364 days from the next 364 days.

The 4 Intercalary days divide the 4 seasons and are added to the days of the year to make 364 days only.

Here we see the continuance of the 4 intercalary days from 82: 4-5

Enoch 82: 6

For they belong to the reckoning of the year and are truly recorded  
(thereon) for ever,  
one in the first portal, and  
one in the third, and  
one in the fourth and  
one in the sixth, and  
the year is completed in three hundred and sixty four days.

- 1) Here we see the portals that the 4 intercalary days are to be added to.
- 2) Remember, in the last few hours of each of the 4 intercalary days is when the leader star rises in the east to lead the sun through the leader star's portal, when the sun rises after those leaders stars begins the 1<sup>st</sup> day of each season.

Enoch 74: 11-12

11 And the overplus of the sun and of the stars amounts to six days: in 5 years 6 days: and the moon falls behind the sun and stars to the number of 30 days.

12 And the sun and the stars bring in all the years exactly, so that they do not advance or delay their position by a single day unto eternity; but complete the years with perfect justice in 364 days.
