

John Stallard is the Research Librarian for the Carriage Association of America and Assistant Editor of The Carriage Journal, which is a scholarly journal of carriages, their use, and their rich & evolving history. Based in Lexington, Kentucky he is an avid horseman and carriage driver and contributes articles on carriages and their history to international publications. His most recent engagements have been as a presenter at the 2022 The Horse & the Country House conference (University of Cambridge), a speaker at the 2024 CAA International Carriage Symposium (Washington, DC), & has recently returned from France examining carriages and their role during the long 18th century in France during a course entitled Court Culture and the Horse 1700-1900: Versailles, Chantilly, and Compiègne.


