From the Archives

From the Prince Albert Daily Herald - November 26, 1949 - "Latest in a long line of memorials, carillonic bells recently installed at St. Alban's Cathedral here will be dedicated tomorrow. The bells, paid for by public subscription among the Cathedral membership, are intended as a memorial to those of the Anglican faith who gave their lives in the Second World War. The service is scheduled for 3:00pm and will be conducted by Canon W.S. Noble, B.A., L.Th. The dedication ceremony will be performed by Rt. Rev. H.D. Martin, D.D., Bishop of Saskatchewan. Mayor J.M.
