From the Archives

The April 22, 1919 Prince Albert Daily Herald wrote that two silver medals and five certificates were awarded to the pupils of St. Alban's Sunday School on Easter Sunday. The address and presentation were made by Archdeacon Dewdney at the children's afternoon service at 3:00pm. Jack Hicks, aged ten years, carried away both medals, one being for the highest marks in the junior grade in the Dominion of Canada, and the other medal being for the highest marks obtained in any grade in the Diocese of Saskatchewan. Jack went on to become an internationally recognized poet and musician, especially loved for his sixty years as organist at St. Alban's Cathedral. Jack passed away in 1999.
