From the Archives

From Prince Albert Daily Herald, July 6, 1920 - "Members of St. Alban's congregation, young and old, and friends will picnic tomorrow afternoon about a mile north of the river a little west of the rifle ranges. The kind and generous consent of the Prince Albert band to attend is a source of great satisfaction for nothing adds as much to an outing and gives it such an inspiring touch as strains of music. The management is anxious that a bountiful supply of provisions be brought by those attending and that everyone will enter into the spirit of the occasion and take their part to make the outing pleasant and profitable. A start for the grounds will be made at one o'clock, and through the kindness of those who possess cars will be carried thither. Those who intend to go should line up at or near St. Alban's between one and two o'clock." (Photo included on Mailchimp.)
