From the Archives

From the Archives - "Roberta E. Tilton ACW Report of Turkey Supper - October 14, 1961 - The eleventh annual turkey supper, held in the Church Hall, was held October 14/61." The report notes that there are conveners for Kitchen, Tables, Desserts, Turkeys, Vegetables, Salads, Beverages and Tickets. Twenty turkeys were ordered. Bread for the dressing (about 30 pounds) was ordered from the Danish Home Bakery. The turkeys and the bread were delivered to the volunteers on Thursday and Friday, in order for the turkeys and dressing to be delivered to the Hall on either Friday night or Saturday morning, as the carvers started around 10:00am to carve them. Twenty-five pounds of cabbage was ordered for salad, along with an order to Purity Dairy for 23 quarts of milk, 9 quarts of cream milk, and ten pounds of butter. In addition, members were asking to bring six tea towels, extra ashtrays, two large or medium sized pies and a pint of cranberry sauce. Approximately 432 guests were served, not including Roberta members for a total of \$503, less expenses of \$232.20, leaving a profit of \$286.35.
