May 17, 1952 - "Men Entertain At St. Alban's Maytime Tea" - Individual potted plants graced the tables at the Maytime Tea, sponsored by the men of St. Alban's held in the Cathedral hall on Saturday afternoon. Pastel shaded streamers decorated the hall, while large silver vases of carnations, snapdragons and roses centred the tea tables. Tall yellow tapers in silver holders flanked the centrepiece of the tables which were draped with lace cloths. CC Riach was in charge of the register, which was signed by 401 guests."
