From the Archives

From the Prince Albert Daily Herald - January 25, 1954 - "Canon Taylor thanked members of the corporation, leaders of women's organizations and choir members. He said the statistical report had shown a slight increase in attendance. C.J. Asp, chairman of finance committee, reported operating expenses last year were \$13,836.76 with expenditures of \$14,336.61, leaving a deficit of \$499.85. Total of \$1318.51 was contributed by women's organizations. G.M. Salter, Q.C., reported that several gifts had been received including a new chancel carpet, steel chairs for the hall, new fan for unit heater and choir robes. Mrs. W.G. Elder, president of the General branch of the Women's Auxiliary, reported the formation of a new branch in the west end, to be called the Bishop Lloyd branch."
