From the Archives

From the Saskatchewan Times - February 1, 1893 - "On Thursday last the children of the English Church Sunday Schools were entertained at Saskatchewan Hall by friends of the schools. A bountiful repast had been prepared by the ladies of the Church, of which the children heartily partook and thoroughly enjoyed. The presents from the Christmas tree were then distributed, much to the delight of the little ones, each and all receiving their share of the good things contained thereon. The evening's amusement was brought to a close by a magic lantern exhibition, which had been procured for the occasion, and which was thoroughly enjoyed by all present. Several of the members of the Church were present and done their share in assisting the pastor, Ven. Archdeacon Geo. McKay.
