Who does what?

A deacon, a lay reader and a server walk into a church . . .
 Now that I have your attention, here are the differences between these three positions.

Deacon - ordained by the Bishop as a member of the clergy, is the only one to read the Gospel, take Reserve Sacrament services, and prepare the altar for a communion service.

Lay Reader/Lay Assistant - a member of a congregation that reads lessons, assists with the chalice and takes Morning Prayer services. Any confirmed lay member can also do these tasks.

Server - these individuals carry the processional cross and assist the deacon with setting and clearing the altar for a communion service.

A Lay Reader, Lay Assistant and a Server must all be confirmed.

All roles complement each other but are stand alone positions.
