From Archives

From the Archives - after the lovely weddings on Saturday, (one at St. Alban's and one at St. Mary's), we are in a romantic mood, historically speaking. At the suggestion of one of the historians at the Bill Smiley Archives at the Historical Museum, I searched for the first wedding to be celebrated in the new St. Alban's Pro-Cathedral. The first service in the new building was held on Christmas Day, 1905, and this is the first wedding recorded in the parish register after the new year. On April 8, 1906, George Edward Bonshor was joined in Holy Matrimony to Lizzie Norgrove, by the Rev. Dewdney. There are no baptisms recorded under Bonshor, so the couple may have left Prince Albert for another community. Best wishes to everyone!
