From the Archives

Prince Albert Daily Herald - October 20, 1970 - by Marg Jaspar, Herald Reporter - "Very Rev. H.V.R. Short, Dean of St. Alban's Cathedral and bishop-elect of the Diocese of Saskatchewan, says that though he has a reputation as an academic, he sees himself as a pastoral man. "The key man in the church today is the parish priest and it is the bishop's job to encourage and support him", Dean Short said. "I don't think renewal comes from committees but from a growing understanding and commitment to the mission of the church on the past of its members, most of whom are laymen," he said. "Renewal must be spontaneous, It cannot be created by blue prints," he said. Dean Short, on being consecrated Nov. 29, will have spiritual dominion over one of the largest dioceses in Canada - one which covers 89,744 square miles." By the time of his retirement, Bishop Short had confirmed 148 people in the Cathedral. (See photo on Mailchimp).
