Peggy Kerr was a treasured member of the Cathedral Chancel Guild for decades, and was also deeply involved in the maintenance and cleanliness of St. Mary's church and cemetery. She was also an active member of the Horticultural Society, the Historical Society, the Watsonaires and Sharp Needles. She loved nothing better than a major festival at the Cathedral, and her creative spirit and skills combined to provide outstanding decorative effects. The bronze plaque on the edge of "Peggy's garden" was installed by the Chancel Guild and reads in part "she saw beauty in creation as the handiwork of God".
