From Archives

From a letter from T.E. Baker, Builder and Contractor, dated December 14, 1903 - "The building committee on the Rectory beg to report as follows. That they have carefully examined the building & recommend the payment to Mr. Holmes of twenty-three hundred and twenty dollars \$2320.00. We also recommend that the sum of twenty dollars be withheld until the work is completed. We herewith enclose Mr. Knox's report also Mr. Holmes' account. Your committee also beg to report that they have insured the building for fifteen hundred dollars for 3 yrs the premium \$33.75 which becomes due on Jan 1st, 1904. Respectfully yours, A. Agnew, Chairman"
