From the Prince Albert Times - December 26, 1905 - "The new English church has been completed and will be opened for the first time next Monday, Christmas Day, when the usual Christmas services will be held at 11 a.m. Right Rev. Bishop Newnham will preach the sermon. Special music has been provided. The pews for the church not having arrived, the wardens have arranged to have the seats from the city hall placed in the church for the occasion."
