From the Archives

March 12, 1963 - A public service of ordination and Holy Communion held Tuesday night in St. Alban's Cathedral marked the opening of the biennial synod of the Diocese of Saskatchewan in Prince Albert. Rt. Rev. W.H.H. Crump, Bishop of Saskatchewan, officiated at the opening service and ordained Rev. Gerald Spence, missionary at Paddockwood, to the priesthood. The candidate was presented by the examining chaplains, Prof. J.D.F. Beattie, Emmanuel College, Saskatoon, and Archdeacon W.F. Payton.
