From the Archives

From the Archives - I was scanning the archives shelves searching for inspiration for today's bulletin when I came across an old and dusty box labelled "Confirmation veils", and inside were veils not used in decades. A search of our photo archives yielded the attached photo, with no information apart that it was taken in Meadow Lake. Some of the women who were confirmed some time ago (me among them) may remember the sometimes-strict protocols around proper attire when the Bishop visited for Confirmation. The veils in our office may not match exactly but they are very similar. This particular style could not charitably be described as "flattering". An Anglican female friend remembers wearing a veil for Confirmation, and that the Bishop explained that he must be able to touch your head, so the very popular poofy 60s hair of the time had to be flattened down.
