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From Archives

From the Archives - this week, good friends dropped off a glorious bouquet of gladiolas from G&G Gladiolus in Shellbrook. They reminded me of a long serving and dedicated parishioner of the Cathedral, Lil Jacobs. Miss Jacobs was a staunch member of the Horticultural Society, and the flowers, especially the glads she gifted to the Cathedral were always incredibly beautiful. A story in the April 8, 1953 Prince Albert Daily Herald tells us that Dr. O.K. Hjertaas was elected president of the Prince Albert Gladioli Society, and Miss Jacobs was elected second vice-president. Another story dated September 22, 1952, tells us that the Cathedral celebrated two special occasions, as the Rev. R.L. Taylor, recently appointed Rector, conducted his first service, and that the Cathedral was decorated with field and garden produce of the bumper harvest from Prince Albert and district. Miss Jacobs was buried on March 2, 1996, from the Cathedral and buried in St. Mary's Cemetery. (See photos on Mailchimp).
