From the Archives

Prince Albert Daily Herald - March 3, 1956 - Canon Payton was the guest speaker at the Prince Albert Quota club. His subject was the early history of Prince Albert. "After Saskatoon became a flourishing settlement, the University of Saskatchewan was established there, and Emmanuel college was federated with it as the Faculty of Theology. Prince Albert was thus the beginning of settlement and also the beginning of education in this province. Canon Payton spoke of the traditions of the past which we must uphold and of the challenge to build the future. He spoke of our debt to the Indians of those early times, of their willingness to learn and to forward the best of Christianity. There has been exploitation of the Indians by white men. We must remember the heroism, steadfastness, loyalty and faith which the Indians have shown and realize that they can build with us the future of our country."
