From the Archives

From the Prince Albert Daily Herald - 1945 - "The Girls' Leaders council of St. Alban's Cathedral held a most successful mother and daughter banquet in the Cathedral Hall recently when approximately 70 guests attended. The colors of the Women's Auxiliary, blue and white, were chosen for the color scheme for the beautifully decorated tables. Canon Noble introduced the guest speakers, Mrs. H.D. Martin, Mrs. L.A. Page and Miss Punter. Mrs. C.W. Ilsley reminded the girls of the annual spring festival to be held at the Scout camp and of the Anglican girls camp at Okema Beach, Emma Lake, early in July. Mrs. Martin addressed the mothers, stressing the value of the church and its training for the girls. The concluding item on the program was a sing song, led by Miss Punter." (See photo on Mailchimp)
