From Archives

From the Archives - this excerpt from the September 12, 1921, Prince Albert Daily Herald is written about a staff gift to the retiring Bishop Newnham - "The members of the staff (St. Alban's College) presented the school with two beautiful life-size oil portraits of Bishop and Mrs. Newnham. We feel that it is most appropriate that we should have these pictures in our assembly hall, as Bishop and Mrs. Newnham were responsible for the founding of the school, of which the Bishop is the President. The pictures are the work of the art mistress, Miss Kenworthy Browne, who cleverly caught the expressions of countenance with which we are so familiar." (Note - St. Alban's College was located at about Central Avenue and 20th Street, across from PACI, and operated from approximately 1909 - 1931).
