From Archives

From the Archives - We have a number of interesting and historically important items tucked away in Cathedral corners, and on the walls. One of my favourite items is the large piece of blue silk fabric embroidered with gold metallic thread, in the "Queensway" pattern. This fabric, which was draped throughout the interior of Westminster Abbey for Queen Elizabeth II's Coronation, was likely produced by Warner & Sons. The blue fabric hung in the nave, and a gold fabric hung in the chancel of the Abbey, symbolising the transition into the most sacred space in the building. Pieces of fabric were eventually sent to every Anglican cathedral in the Commonwealth. The red leather box used for shipping is in Archives. When leaving the Cathedral today, look up to the left of the west Memorial window, and take a moment to remember the woman who served the Commonwealth selflessly for 96 years, and as Queen from 1952 - 2022.
