From the Archives

Prince Albert Daily Herald - December, 1917 - "The women's organizations of St. Alban's church are prepared for the opening of their bazaar at the Publicity building tomorrow afternoon when there will be a display of articles of apparel, eatables and Christmas gifts which in point of volume and worth is said to exceed any previous effort of the St. Alban's ladies. A feature of the bazaar will be a fortune-tellers' booth where those who desire to peer into the future may have their curiosity gratified. Homemade cooking of tempting quality will be offered for sale and afternoon tea is to be served with the daintiness of a high class cafe. It is anticipated that the people of the city will attend the event in large numbers." (Editorial note - the Publicity building stood on the corner of Central Avenue and 12th Street, where the Bank of Montreal was and now houses Novus Law Group.) (See photos on Mailchimp.)
