### From the Archives

February 28, 1915 - the Prince Albert Daily Herald reported that the quarterly meeting of the executive committee of the Diocese held in the basement of the St. Alban's Pro Cathedral discussed the strain which the enlistment of clergymen, students and laymen has placed upon the operations of the Diocese. More Anglicans have enlisted for service in the war than have gone from any other denomination. In this diocese alone, 13 clergymen and nearly 40 students have enlisted. Recognition of the supreme sacrifice made by so many in both World Wars is shown by the west Memorial Window, carillon bells, and plaques commemorating some of the men lost in battle.
