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From the Archives (in honour of the start of this season's NHL games)

Prince Albert Daily Herald - March 1, 1928 - St. Alban's and St. George's church league hockey teams met at the rink yesterday afternoon in the decisive affray of this year's schedules. St. Alban's won 5-1. The Cathedral boys prevailed over their opponents to such an extent that the final game of this winter's series might have been supposed. Considering that both teams had only one defeat to their credit a rather snappier mill had been anticipated. However, the St. Alban's crew, led by Georgie Greening won the day. Puckett scored in the first half minute for St. Alban's and again near the end of the first period. He again shot one past Hayes in the second frame and was followed up by Foskett. Sims got the St. George's only score, in the second stanza, and Vic Puckett sailed through the opposing defence again in the third period for the final tally. St. Alban's team - C. Davidson, K.
