From the Archives

In the late 1940’s and early 1950’s, the men of St. Alban’s organized a “Maytime Tea”. The decorations, flowers and food were provided by other Cathedral organizations, while the men had duties of greeting and serving. Ladies attending received corsages, and no doubt admired the large silver vases of carnations, snapdragons, and roses on the lace covered tea tables. A total of 401 ladies signed the guest register for the May 16, 1949 event.
