From Archives

From the Cathedral Chimes - March 1972 - "Five of the newly confirmed have an intimate relationship with clergy of the Diocese. Margaret Short, Stephen McMulkin, Geoffrey Payton, Daphne Rowe, are children of the Bishop, the Dean, Archdeacon Payton, and the Rev. W.J. Rowe (in that order), and Brett Watson is the grandson of the Rev. A.C. Smith, Geoffrey Payton is also a brother of a priest of the Diocese, the Rev. R.J. Payton. This must be a rather unique situation, and we plan to get a picture of these Confirmees with the clergy to whom they are related. Incidentally, March 19 was also the 65th birthday of Archdeacon Payton. So, at the reception after the service, everyone sang "Happy Birthday" for him." (Editorial note - despite my best archival search efforts, sadly there is no photo.)
