From the Archives

The 10th Synod of the Diocese of Saskatchewan was held July 23 to 26th, 1905 (120 years ago). The First Session was held at City Hall on July 24 at 10am with the Bishop (Jervois Newnham) in the chair. He opened the Synod with prayer. Bishop Newnham and his wife invited the delegates and their wives to meet the congregation of St. Alban's at a reception at Bishopsthorpe (the Bishop's residence) this evening from 8:00pm to 11:00pm. They also invited the delegates to Synod to lunch at Bishopsthorpe at 12:30. During his charge, Bishop Newnham recognized the life and work of the Rev. John Badger, who died in February, 1905. He served faithfully in Fort a la Corne, St. James' Mission, Sandy Lake Mission, and Sturgeon Lake. The wonderful oil portraits of Bishop and Mrs. Newnham are held in the Synod Office. Bishop Newnham was responsible for the construction of the large brick house which still stands on the corner of 2nd Avenue West and 21st Street. It subsequently became the Synod Office and was later turned into apartments after being sold.
