Prince Albert Daily Herald, February 6, 1971: Rev. J.H. McMulkin, 45, who has been appointed Dean of St. Alban's Cathedral, arrived in Prince Albert Thursday and will take his first service in the Cathedral Sunday. He replaces Rt Rev H.V.R. Short, Bishop of Saskatchewan, who was formerly Dean of the Cathedral prior to his election as Bishop.
