From Archives

From the Archives - the visit of the Most Rev. Shane Parker, Primate of Canada, brings to mind a Diocesan connection to the Most Rev. Samuel Pritchard Matheson, Archbishop of Rupert's Land, and the longest serving Primate of All Canada (1909 - 1930). His cousin, the Rev. Canon Edward K. Matheson, served in this Diocese his entire life. Descended from Lord Selkirk's Red River settlers, the cousins served the early Church with distinction and devotion in the face of considerable challenges. In 1884, Edward travelled by the new railroad to Red River and was accompanied on his return to Prince Albert by his cousin, now Canon S.P. Matheson of St. John's Cathedral. In 1912, Edward was the first graduate of in theology from Emmanuel College. Bishop Newnham appointed Edward Matheson a Canon of St. Alban's Pro-Cathedral. Mrs. Elizabeth Matheson is revered for her work as a medical doctor in the area and her life story is in itself remarkable.
