

Meet Travel Costs

All athletes and families are accountable for their expenses to competitions, including hotel and travel arrangements.

ZnZ gymnasts must travel with a parent, legal guardian, or in a pre-arranged scenario with another family. Traveling with a coach is **prohibited**.

ZnZ Gymnastics Center and ZnZ Gymnastics Booster Club are not responsible for any outof-pocket travel expenses incurred or lost.

Meet hosts typically reserve hotel blocks to get rooms at a discounted rate. This information will be conveyed via email.

Competition Guidelines

Gymnast must meet certain criteria in order to be allowed to compete.

Some reasons a gymnast may not compete an event or competition can include, but are not limited to:

- Absenteeism
- Inadequate meet preparation
- Lack of required skills
- Poor academics
- Illness
- Injury
- Tuition and/or meet fees not paid up to date
- Inappropriate behavior while representing ZnZ

Where a gymnast does not compete in a scheduled competition, meet fees are non-refundable (injury is a sometime exception)

Scratches from a Competition

If a gymnast cannot compete due to an injury or unforeseen extenuating circumstances the club administrator will request a refund from the host club. Refund policies are handled at the discretion of the host club.

If you are unable to attend a competition for any reason, you must inform your team coach ASAP. Any notice of absence from a competition that is past the meet due date is not eligible for a refund.

All awarded refunds will be applied and adjusted to the 4th meet fee due March 1st.

ZnZ Athlete Code of Conduct

- As a member o the ZnZ Gymnastics team, you are expected to conduct yourself in a manner befitting of a ZnZ athlete.
- Your behavior and actions show respect for our gym, the coaches, your teammates, and most importantly, YOURSELF!
- Team Member Expectations:
 - Report on time for training to the best of your abilities
 - Practice mutual respect with your teammates and coaches
 - Call the gym and notify the office when you will be late or absent
 - Listen to, respect, and adhere to the training outline
 - Only enter the gym floor with permission from your coach
 - Report injuries immediately

Use of the Locker Room

- Cell phones or any device with the ability to take photos/video recording are prohibited.
- Open container food/beverages are prohibited in the locker.
- No horseplay, running, or chasing.
- No throwing or hiding objects.
- The locker room is not a hang out area.
- Keep your locker tidy
- Anyone found defacing, damaging, or violating the rules is subject to disciplinary action and/or potential loss of locker room privilege.
