





Fundraising Update

• Fireworks

- ZGBC operated a Wild Willy's Firework stand for a period of 7 days.
- Approximately 720 volunteer hours worked.
- Total fundraising revenue from the event was \$10,857.42!!
- Fundraiser provided seed funding for initial Season Kick-off Party.
- ZGBC has committed to Wild Willy's to operate the same stand in 2024.
- Additionally, ZGBC will be submitting an application to be a Permit Holder in 2024 which would allow us to double our firework fundraising efforts.

 Omaha City Mayor gets 5 nominations
 Omaha Fireworks Committee get 3 nominations


Fundraising Update

MEMBERSHIP COSTS

Costs Associated with Competition

ZnZ gymnasts will incur four(4) types of fees associated with each competition season:

- 1) Annual Dues (aka Booster Club Fees, per handbook)
- 2) Uniforms
- 3) USAG
- 4) Meet Registrations

MEMBERSHIP COSTS (Annual Dues)

- ZGBC dues are put in place to cover the following:
 - Coach Fees
 - Meet Sesion Fees (\$60 per coach per session)
 - Mileage (Current Rate = \$0.655/Mile)
 - Meal Per Diems (\$55 Full Day & \$41.25 on Travel Days)
 - Lodging
 - Airfare
 - Rental Car
 - Team Fees
- Coaches provided a detailed budget for the 2023-2024 season which fees totaled approximately \$35,000 to determine the annual dues.
- Membership dues were broken down multiple ways which included by gymnast, by family, by session and by meet to cover expenses.
- Membership dues can be paid in full or 3 installments w/ TeamSnap App or personal check.

MEMBERSHIP COSTS (Cont'd)

- A combination of breakdowns were used to come up with reasonable amount based on ALL the contributing factors:
 - Men's & Women's Level 3 = \$180
 - Men's & Women's Level 4-6 plus XCEL Bronze and Silver = \$300
 - Men's & Women's Level 7-10 plus XCEL Diamond, Gold & Platinum = \$420
 - Siblings = \$75
- The goals of Booster Club include supporting gymnasts in their journey to National Level Competition.
 - Competition costs create a financial barrier for both higher level & sibling gymnasts.
 - Annual dues were set with these barriers in mind.
 - The determination was made to break up the coach's travel fees per family and coach's session fees per gymnast.
 - The siblings cost was a result of the coach's travel being assigned per family to the highest level gymnast.

- Uniforms must be paid for "in full" in order to RECEIVE your uniform
- BEFORE the first competition January
- Invoices can be split as needed using TeamSnap



Other Incurred USAG Costs...

State & Regional "head tax"

- Fee associated with individual registration per State or Regional Director
 - May be paid at time of registration,
 - Possibility we may need to collect in advance
- O Do not know exact dollar amount at this time:
 - Boys previously has been <\$20/gymnast
 - Girls sometimes figured by size of team, other times by individual



INDIVIDUAL MEET FEES

INDIVIDUAL MEET FEES

- Individual registration fees are charged for each gymnast AT THE TIME OF REGISTRATION
 - Often 4-12 weeks in advance of competition
 - ZnZ coaches will register gymnasts.
- Registration cost vary by meet for both girls and boys (Range from \$75 \$175/meet)
 - Collected via TeamSnap
 - Invoice including all meets up to State, Regional, Nationals
 - May be paid in full, or installments
 - However, must receive payment by registration deadline
 - Methods of payment
 - TeamSnap Registration App (processing fees will apply)
 - Personal Check delivered to gym or PO Box (coming soon)
- ZGBC must submit fees to host meet, by deadline!!
 - If check is not received, gymnasts will not be "officially" registered



How can I offset my costs?

Let's Revisit fundraising opportunities, And introduce some more...

Raise Right

- Raise Right is a platform that allows families to raise funds for their specific gymnast through scrip fundraising.
 - Similar to TAGG program, if used with other organizations
- What is Scrip Fundraising?
 - Allows you to raise money by using GIFT CARDS instead of cash or credit to pay for everyday purchases like groceries, gas, dining out, etc.
 - 90% of the money raised is returned to the gymnasts!
 - The remaining 10% goes to the Booster Club's general fund.
- Money raised can be utilized for future dues and/or meet fees.
 - *Booster Club is finalizing how the funds will be credited to TeamSnap and timing of disbursement.

• <u>Important to understand</u>:

- Monies from Raise Right are donated funds.
- NO refunds to individuals allowed per IRS guideline for 501(c)3.
- If gymnast is no longer a booster club member then raised funds are turned over to booster club's general fund.



What does it mean to be a 501c3?

Some organizations do not have this opportunity



IRS Items of Note

<u>Inurement</u>:

 No part of the net earnings of the booster club may inure to the benefit of any private shareholder or individual.

Cooperative Fundraising:

• No system rewarding parents with booster funds based on time or effort contributed to the Booster Club or fundraising activities is allowed.

Donations:

Donors can dictate how donated funds are to be utilized.

Distributions:

• Funds are allowed to be distributed based on objective and nondiscriminatory criteria such as athletic performance, talent and ability.

Disbursement Example

These numbers are estimated for the purpose of an example:

- *Booster Club fundraisers generate \$25,000 above operating expenses.
 - \$25k \$5k (hold over for next season) = \$20k;
 - \$20k * 0.15 = \$3k for national qualifiers;
 - \$17k for membership distribution.

Family Example with 2 gymnasts:

- Level 7 optional gymnast pay 1.7% of the total fees returned \$289
 - (\$17k * 1.7%) disbursement.
- A level 5 compulsory sibling pay 0.78% of the total fees returned \$132.60
 - (\$17k * 0.78%) disbursement.

The annual fee for both siblings could be \$500 (\$425 for optional plus \$75 for sibling) and at the end of the season would get \$421.60 dollars dispersed. Uniform fees and meet fees will vary based on if uniforms are needed and which meets are attended. If the level 7 qualifies for nationals, that gymnast would get an additional distribution (\$3k / # of qualifiers) for nationals.
