Terms & Conditions of Membership

- 1. Membership Dues.** The annual dues for membership are **\$50.00**, paid no later than the March meeting, in the year in which they are due. Failure to do so will result in suspension of membership and privileges. Once removed, such persons must re-apply for membership, and be approved by the membership, as would a new member.
- 2. Work Hours.** Every Annual member is obligated to perform 15 hours of service to the organization, each year. Credit for work hours may be obtained by performing a variety of tasks, including (but not limited to): building/grounds maintenance, helping to organize or staff club events, selling raffle tickets, etc.

Members MUST report their work hours to the Membership Committee within 30 days of service, and in any case, no later than the next monthly meeting. **Members will record their work hours on a form furnished by the Membership Committee. A clipboard with this form is located on the wall, near the restrooms, in the clubhouse.** Members will not receive credit for hours not reported within 30 days of service.

A fee is assessed for each hour of service not performed, which is charged in addition to the following year's dues, and must be paid along with the member's following year dues. Failure to pay this fee shall be considered the same as having not paid dues. The fee is **\$25.00** for each hour not worked.

- 3. Pro-rated Dues and Hours.** New members shall only be responsible for a pro-rated amount of dues and work hours, based on the month in which their application is approved by the membership. Dues and hours shall be pro-rated as follows:

- 4. Key Card.** New members will be issued a magnetic key card that operates the entrance gate and club house doors. There is a onetime fee of **\$10.00** for your card. If you lose or damage your card, a replacement card costs **\$10.00**.
- 5. Club Website.** It is the responsibility of each member to periodically check the club website (trumbullcountyrobandgun.com) for important news and updates regarding the club. The website is a central point of distribution for club information, newsletters, and other important information. By getting your information from the website, you help the club save money that can be put to use in other ways to benefit the club.
- 6. Illness or death.** Please be sure that your family knows to notify the club of any major illness or injury, or death. This information is important, because it will allow for certain administrative actions to be performed on your behalf, including work hours adjustments/waivers, update of membership rolls, etc. Also ensure that you maintain emergency contact information with the club.
- 7. Personal Membership.** Each membership is a "personal" membership, the benefits of which only extend to members of the member's immediate family (spouse and children under 21 years of age). Other adult family members and friends may occasionally accompany a member to club events or to use the club facilities, as a guest or as a prospective member of the club. However, these others may not regularly accompany a club member as though they themselves were a member. Family and friends who enjoy visiting our club and using our facilities should be encouraged to become a member in their own right.
- 8. Protection of Club Property.** It is the responsibility of each member to protect all club property, equipment, and facilities. Members must report any misuse of club property or any inappropriate or dangerous behavior observed. Any member may ask any other individual to identify themselves and to present their membership card; every member must anticipate and fully cooperate with any such request for identification.
- 9. Rental.** From time to time, the club will make the clubhouse available for rental, or the club will plan and conduct special activities and events. All members will honor the arrangements for such rental events and club activities by not making personal use of the club facilities in an interfering manner.
- 10. Adherence to Club Rules.** It is the responsibility of every member to act in accordance with all club rules, policies, and practices. Any question regarding club rules and policies should be directed to the President or to his designated representative. Failure to comply with club rules and policies is grounds for suspension or revocation of your membership.
