 Each entrant is responsible for riding a properly conditioned horse in a safe manner.
 Management reserves the right to stop and eliminate unsafe riders or improperly
 conditioned horses.
- 2. Properly fitting helmet with permanent harness & boots with heels required whenever mounted. Numbers must be worn and clearly visible at all times when mounted.
- 3. The competition will be conducted in accordance with the rules of the United States Eventing Association as described in the current rule book. Which can be found at https://www.usef.org/compete/resources-forms/rules-regulations/rulebook.
- 4. Divisions not recognized by USEA rules can be found at steventing.net. USEF rules will be followed for the Jumpers and Xrail/WTC classes.
- 5. Ribbons will be awarded through sixth place. Divisions may be divided or combined to compensate for excessive or inadequate entries.
- 6. If entered in CT, you MUST complete your CT show jumping phase BEFORE you complete any other jumping class.
