Dear Coaches,

Congratulations and welcome to the National 4-H Livestock Quiz Bowl competition being held in Louisville, Kentucky in conjunction with the North American International Livestock Exposition. We hope you will have a fun and educational experience during your stay in Louisville.

Being selected to represent your state for this event is a high honor. The contest will be held on Tuesday, November 14th, starting at 9 am. Location of the National 4-H Livestock Quiz Bowl competition will be at the Kentucky Fair and Exposition Center (KFEC). We have 13 states represented in this year's national contest. The contest rooms are South Wing - C108, C109, and C112. Team Check-in and contestant holding rooms are C101 and C104. The contest should conclude about 5:00 pm or earlier on Tuesday. Only the Head Coach (one) and up to 5 team members will be allowed in the holding room while the contest is being conducted.

Contestants may NOT watch any other matches until their team has been eliminated from the competition. If your team is eliminated, you may watch other matches, but you must be quiet while the match is being conducted. If a member of your team needs to leave the contest area Res room break), the coach should notify me or the room moderator

There will be a Coach's meeting on Monday night, November 13th, 8 pm, at the Crowne Plaza, Coronet B. Informational packets (contest brackets, etc.), will be distributed at this time. You will have the opportunity to purchase additional tickets for the Awards Breakfast or pick up purchased breakfast tickets for Wednesday morning. Tickets are \$20 each for the breakfast and check is payable to the Tennessee 4-H Foundation. I've attached an Order Form for you to complete and bring to the coaches meeting on Monday night. Teams are allocated 5 tickets for the breakfast. Additional tickets must be purchased. Tickets are required to enter and attend the Awards Breakfast ceremony.

A lunch buffet will be provided this year for quiz bowl teams, and each team will be allocated 5 tickets for lunch. Teams will be confined to the holding or contest rooms. Other individuals will need to have lunch at their own expense.

The Awards Breakfast will be held on Wednesday, November 15th, at the KFEC, South Wing, Rooms C201-205 to recognize our outstanding individuals and teams from contests. Team photos start at 7 am and breakfast begins at 8 am with awards to follow.



The Awards Breakfast dress is business casual. Remember they will be taking your team photo the first thing in the morning.

Each state team can request up to 5 badges (gate passes) for accessing the KFEC grounds. These will be available in the Carroll Room located at the Crowne Plaza. Louisville Airport Expo Center. These passes cover admittance and parking on the grounds.


Extra Banquet Breakfast Ticket Purchases
