would like + pronoun + infinitive (E.g. We would like you to join us for a dinner) and Polite requests with would and could (Would you like to join us?)

so vs. Such (E.g. That book was **so** interesting / That was **such** an interesting book)

Modal auxiliary verbs = Ability (can-could-be able) / Advice (should - ought to) / Permission (may - can) / Necessity (have to - must)

so / too / either / neither (E.g. So do I / I do too / Neither did I / I didn't either)

Passive voice (Simple present, past and future / Present perfect / Present and past progressive)

defining and non defining relative clauses and relative pronouns
(Who/which/that/where/when)

Past perfect and past perfect progressive tenses

Time clauses (before/ after/ When/ since/ While / As soon as / until)
