PRICES CIRCUIT RESERVE PLAYGROUND

WVRA Inc. Committee submitted the following information to council in February 2024. This was part of Sutherland Shire Councils Community consultation to access the renewal and relocation of the playground at Prices Circuit Reserve.

Two options were provided in the survey section:

- 1. Option A was near the shopping complex car park.
- 2. Option B was south of the reserve in the existing open space.

At our previous general Association meetings, the consensus was to leave Prices Circuit Reserve as a quiet space for people to relax, read, fish and, be still. The members agreed and decided that the community would benefit most if the reserve was to be free of children's play equipment with the trees being replaced rather than the play equipment.

This was not one of the options in the survey, so our committee submitted this information for Councils consultation and consideration.

On behalf of Woronora Valley Residents Association Inc. (WVRA), we submit the following information which has been discussed at our previous meetings.

Our residents have advised that they would prefer to keep this small and beneficial reserve, free of playground equipment. Residents would prefer this reserve to be a quiet space where there is easy wheelchair access. People also enjoy fishing, reading and, relaxing, free of children and their activities. This park is particularly appreciated by Elderly people to enjoy the peaceful surroundings of Woronora River.

Close by are excellent playgrounds for children with a variety of equipment at Burnum Burnum Reserve and Prince Edward Park which are both within walking distance and provide amenities.

For these reasons, our Association does not support Option A, and Option B is not suitable being close to Prices Circuit and parking could be a safety issue being on top of the hill.

We hope you will take this information into consideration when making your decision.
