The signage, now in place at both the upper and lower access points of the Woronora Fire Trail, plays a vital role in identifying this area as recognised koala habitat. This initiative contributes significantly to raising community awareness and promoting the protection and survival of local koala populations.

Residents and visitors are encouraged to observe and adhere to the guidance provided on the signage, and to actively support efforts aimed at safeguarding this wildlife species.

Importantly, the signage reinforces that the Woronora Fire Trail functions as a designated **WILDLIFE CORRIDOR** and must remain closed at all times, except in the case of authorised emergency use.

Signage can be seen at both ends of the Fire Trail, from The Crescent and Warangaree Drive.
