We acknowledge your email dated Friday, December 5, 2025 regarding the request for Wildlife Signs to be installed on the Fire Trail from The Crescent, Woronora to Woronora Heights which is a wildlife corridor. We suggest the signs could be solar flashing Koala signs similar to the sign recently erected on Prince Edward Park Road opposite Mersey Street, Woronora. We also request the painted "wildlife sign" on The Crescent Fire Trail Road could be re-painted, further noting the importance of this corridor.
