You child will have their own individual education support plan (IESP) that will be shared and reviewed with you termly; we'd encourage you to share targets with class staff you'd like to work towards at home so we can support you the best we can.

In order to support your child's learning and overall school experience, we ask that you ensure that you:

- check SeeSaw daily for updates and letters sent home electronically you can message class staff directly on this app too but be aware, replies will only be in non-teaching time and not outside school hours.
- let us know via the school landline (01782 624689) if your child is going to be absent by 08:00. Please leave a message if there is no answer.
- keep your child away from school for 48 hours if they have sickness or diarrhoea this is for everyone's safety. Sending them in can lead to absent staff and therefore affect their learning experiences and safety.
- communicate with us any issues that may affect your child's school day i.e. missed breakfast, lack of sleep or showing signs of distress in anyway so we can accommodate and ensure we are meeting needs
