I. Allen German Shepherds (AGS) reserve the right to ensure that every dog/puppy purchased from this kennel be permanently registered as a "von Allen" shepherd as long as the dog lives. Meaning, the new owners are encouraged & expected to name their new addition any name of their choosing including first, middle and even last name if desired, then attaching "von Allen" at the very end of chosen name. *Example: Shady Brook Phillips Von Allen*

II. The desired name is to be chosen and told to AGS **no later than scheduled pick up date.** If the name is changed on the registration for any reason, new owners are considered in breach of contract and legal actions will be sought concerning ownership of the dog being returned back to AGS. **Note: By signing this contract buyer agrees to return legal ownership back to AGS if name is ever changed on registration.** _____ (initial)

If new owner decides to resale said dog/puppy, AGS must be notified in writing and given the new owners contact information. And the new owners must agree to this agreement in keeping registration name.

III. AGS agrees that every dog/puppy sold from this kennel is current on all shots, vaccines and is in good health. We allow a 72 health guarantee vet check on each dog/puppy sold. If within the 72 hr vet check the dog has a **certified vet confirmation in writing** that there is a terminal illness that will prevent a healthy life, AGS will replace the purchased puppy/dog for another of equal value at no additional cost to buyer.

Buyer Obligation:

Buyer agrees that seller will REPOSSESS dog/puppy upon evidence of neglect and/or abuse at no cost to the seller. Buyer agrees to maintain their AGS in good health, provide annual and routine vet check-ups to keep all immunizations up to date and to administer heart worm prevention, if required by your state or country.

Buyer agrees to take proper safeguards for the care and safety of your AGS, including but not limited to, fenced yard, adequate running space, socialization, etc.

Buyer is responsible for transportation costs to and from AGS, unless previous arrangements have been set up.

This contract is non-assignable and non-transferable

Notes and Breeder recommendations:

All AGS puppies are on Victor Nutra Pro for active dogs and puppies.

Keep puppy inside a crate when visiting the vets office until ALL shots have been given.

Take **extreme** caution in exercising your puppy. Do not "over- do it" with running, jogging, jumping, or climbing stairs until your AGS is developed maturely; and at least until age 1, keep walks no more than 5 mins.

Until then, it should be "careful and slow". Up to twelve months of age, natural free running is the best form of exercise for a youngster. For a young pup upon tiring, can easily stop when they wish, and not keep on performing because they wish to please and keep up with you.

Over six months, training on lead could extend to ten minutes if you wish, but again, moderation is the best guide and if a puppy shows an inclination to tire- then stop.

As the German Shepherd is such a fast growing breed the strain of over exercise on the skeletal make up of a youngster is often irreversible. The stretching of ligaments at too early an age or the strain on young growing joints, or the carrying of too much weight on the overall framework can and will do harm to the young puppy and lead to problems in adulthood.

We recommend all customers invest in going to Leerburg.com for all developmental tips per age of your puppy and/or dog so your AGS can properly have all the great benefits of an exceptional, healthy life.

It's a good idea to give vitamins and supplements to your growing puppy to ensure proper growth and strength are gained. And make sure your puppies food/diet is a solid and nutritious one that is designed for a growing, active puppy. *Feeding your puppy 2x a day is recommended (a.m & p.m)*

If by the age of 6 months your AGS puppy's ears aren't standing firm **contact us** before doing anything with them. If not properly done, permanent damage can be done causing unflattering results. **Please feel free to contact us at anytime if you have any questions. We are in this together!**
