

Yes, we all knew Mr. Booth, the plump little man who rushed through Rhodes halls, always with a smile on his round face, always in a hurry, but with time enough for a friendly chat with some ambitious student or an inquiring faculty member. And now — he's gone. But the name of Guy Booth will always remain a legend along the corridors of Rhodes, whoever the students and teachers that inhabit them may be. So, in memory of a job well done, we, the graduating class of June, nineteen hundred and forty-two, do dedicate our High School Annual as a humble token of our appreciation to the smiling, hurried, friendly man we all have loved, Mr. Guy E. Booth.

## CLASS HISTORY

In September of 1938 a bewildered group of freshmen entered the great institution of learning, James Ford Rhodes, and promptly proceeded on a methodical campaign of harassing the illustrious faculty of said school. The greenness of this class was very apparent by the knowing looks present on all the faces and the brilliant advice they rendered to the upper class-men.

Between escapades they proceeded to become recognized members of the student body. The initial step was taken by Arthur "Sugar" Cain who was the first of the class to receive the honor of being presented in the personality sketches of the "Rhodes Review."

The intramural sports spotlight was turned on the "Steven's Stooges" in the ninth grade when they won the National League Intramural Basketball Championship.

Individuals who started out early on the road to sports fame were Dick Zusy and Lawrence Brakeman of the mats and Al Tremaine, Al Pinch, Russ Svec, and Bob Volk, all of whom sparkled on the hardwood. (Stoddard also went out for basketball.)

The tenth grade was memorable in that friendly rivalry was established by the formation of those indomitable clubs, the FGAPRRRRR's and the Remi Hi-Y.

In the eleventh, Gordon Canute, Frame Pelleschi, Tom Peters, and Bill Hnat donated their contagious spirits and boisterousness to a good cause by leading Rhodes students in the cheers that helped tie West Tech O-O.

Kenneth Dunkum received recognition by being acclaimed a superior singer in a vocal contest April 10, 1940.

The first attempt at organizing the class was made in 11B when officers were elected at a meeting which 150 students attended.

Rachel Zwilling was a member of the cast of "America Sings," one of the most successful musicales presented at Rhodes.

With Hollywood talent scouts lurking in every corner of the auditorium, the spring play, "June Mad," became the play of the year, with Myrtle Woehrman, Dorothy Coleman, and Joe Bolster as members of the cast.

Russell Smith, Ivan Kopcok, Red Blodgette, Danny Long, Jim Gustaves, Bob

Hoenig, and Frank Hutman used their superior skill on the silver blades to carry the first Rhodes hockey team through a successful season.

Three events punctuated the eleventh grade, a picnic at which one and all enjoyed themselves, a dance, and a midnight skating party.

The twelfth grade being the twilight of the high school career, became the most important and star-studded year of the four.

Bob Volk became 12B president.

Because of his sterling oratory, Adolph "The Wind" Schanzenbach was elected president of the student council, defeating opponents Leonia Zema, Russell Svec, and Betty Jane Walzak.

The sports field was brightened by the addition of two transfers. Chuck Williamson, who transferred from Buffalo, became a mainstay of the football squad and Don Mayhew, from Columbus, became an able trackster and was elected president of the Boys' Leaders Club.

The outstanding sport occurrence of 1941 was the defeat of West Tech 12-6 by the Rhodes football team. Some members of this team were Paul Kauffmann, Al Matkovick, Bob Volk, Russell Svec, Roland Hiatt, Weldon Blodgette, Bill Scott, Fred Bader, and Ed Kay.

The first Chemistry club in Rhodes history was organized by Moses Raptas.

Two free mustard businesses were established in the cafeteria by the Remis and the rival firm of Cassidy and Bauer, when mustard went up to a cent a dose.

The FGAPRRRRR-Remi rivalry was awakened when the two factions engaged in a half-time floor hockey game and a burlesque basketball game in which the Remis were defeated.

The class was represented in that unforgettable minstrel show by some members of the class, Don Kamps, Fred Danchuk, Christine Wozniak, Fayette Maudsley, Weldon Blodgette, and Adolph Schanzenbach.

A very brilliant evening informal was given on April 25, at which most of the class danced and enjoyed themselves. The decorations symbolized a "Mexican Fiesta."

The social season at Rhodes was ended with a frolicking picnic; the evening formal, where a stranger would mistake it for a Hollywood actors' and actresses' ball; and the Class Day, where all were dressed in their finest. The final event was commencement.

And so we come upon the time of launching 217 lives on the turbulent sea of life. May the future present as much as the past.


# BOYS' SPORT ACTIVITIES
