



## THE CASE OF THE "CRAZY" 200

J.F.R.—This was the school. June '56—This was the class. I'm a cop.

My partner and I were working a detail out at 5100 Biddulph, that night of the prom—June 2. Someone reported overhearing a strange voice speaking a foreign tongue. All we had to go on was the name of this weird language—"Slush Talk". Our job—find the person who spoke it. We questioned everyone at the prom. No one admitted a thing. The case was closed for lack of evidence. Ten years later, the new police chief, **Bill Duffy**, reopened the case. We spent weeks trying to dig up at least one person who was in that class on the famous night, ten years ago. Finally, on the afternoon of June 30, 1966, we located one girl. A lead at last!

It was **Bev Pristas** who is now working in an information booth at Bellevue. She said she didn't know anything about "Slush Talk", but gave us a list of names, addresses, and other information on all the people that were in her class. As we looked over the list of names and occupational data, we found that there were two more employees here connected with the case: **Jerry Fill** and **Ken Clementis**, orderlies. They showed us to the room of one of the "inmates": **Linda Zilka**, driven to Bellevue in her senior year. Talking to her was hopeless! Our only alternative was to visit everyone on the list.

July 1, 7:16 A.M. Next stop—Vassar, the famous girls' college. **Leslie Jabb** is now the dean. **Jim Stuckey** is the physical ed. teacher here, and **Chuck Ponell** is the tennis coach. We also talked to the girls who are attending this college: **Janet Bass**, **Joan Babo**, **Marge DeMattia**, **Nancy Ensley**, **Ruth Frydl**, **Anita Kazol**, **Laverne Kozer**, **Sonia Manchek**, **Dorothy Manfreda**, **Kathy McLaughlin**, **Virginia Nuhser**, **Diana Ross**, **Joan Schiener**, and **Nadene Reimer**. We drew another blank, and went on with the list.

July 2, 7:23 A.M. Another day, another college—Harvard, where we looked up **Donna Benson**, coach on their rowing team. She told us "The Rotten 7" finally made good: **Dave Hazlett** is now a famous lecturer on any and every subject.

**Larry Schade**, a chauffeur driving his "baby" for a sweet old lady with a weak heart.

**Jim Thomas**, a "B.T.O." specializing in getting anybody a deal.

**Ron Szeremeta**, caterer for all types of celebrations and parties, especially "stag parties".

"Skip" **Melzer**, owner of a plush vacation resort in Vermillion on the Lake.

**Karl Eimer**, Lover of Nature, runs a frog nursery. (His side specialty is salamanders.) Since these boys sounded so clean, we didn't even bother questioning them.

Our case was getting nowhere fast. Then, exactly one week after that first lead, at 9:57 A.M. on July 7, we got a phone call from Sergeant **Ron Elchsen** of the downtown police. He said he was holding some suspects

in the "tank" for us to question. My partner and I lost no time in getting there. The suspects turned out to be: **John Balog**, **Chester Bar**, **George Bauer**, **David Czajka**, **Alan DeWorth**, **Charles Glass**, **Bill Herold**, **Norman Petkac**, **James Englehart**, **James Janke**, **Laddie Krivos**, and **Dennis Schwark**. Our questioning ended at 10:07 A.M. Result—nothing.

10:14, the same morning, we received another call. This time it was from Detective **Jimmy Koberling**. Two more suspects. One was **Elliott Goldstein**, arrested for loitering on a street corner. As it happened, he was only collecting pennies for radio-free Israel. The other was **Bob Beech**, a tall suspicious looking man, arrested on a charge of counterfeiting. Neither could help us.

11:39 A.M. Next on the list was **Dick Brown's "Dime-a-Dance" House**. We questioned the owner, but he told us to talk to the girls in his employ. The ticket seller was **Jackie Cerny**. The others were: **Kathy Anshutz**, **Mary Avoy**, **Marilyn Bemer**, **Joanne Budziak**, **Mary Ann Csontos**, **Betty Doeringer**, **Lynne Faust**, **Nancy Henninger**, **Marilyn Meal**, **Carole Peters**, **Lenore Robertson**, **Mary Ann Grzeska**, **Lillian Plocica**, and **Helen Tluca**. The girls didn't know anything, so we waited for the place to open and the customers to come in. 7 P.M. Two Marines came in clutching their Good Conduct Medals. They were: **Mike Kinkopf** and **Larry Brakowiecki**. Both quite innocent. 7:03 P.M. As the regular customers started coming in, we questioned them one by one: **John Grafton**, **Ralph Burianek**, **Carl Henninger**, **William Oit**, **Carl Koehn**, and **Dick Lukash**. Another dead end.

7:52 P.M. As long as we were in this part of the neighborhood, we stopped in a nearby theater where a few of the class were billed. **Diane Scholl**, **Phyllis Kubit**, and **Gall Koons**, the top three actresses of the year, were on stage so we couldn't talk to them. But we managed to question **Ned "Hotshot" Henry**, who had the knife-throwing act during intermission. He was amusing, but no help to the case.

8:15 P.M. Knocked off for something to eat. My partner and I looked over the list of people we were planning to cover the next day, and immediately eliminated **Brian McHugh** because he is now in Italy, rehabilitating the youth. However, the others were:

**Richard Coolidge**—died himself black, now plays with the Harlem Globe Trotters.

**Fred Klimo**—makes dip sticks for his motor.

**Elaine Kosmahl**—still takes driving lessons

from Mr. Seitz.

**Don Reutener**—famous and brilliant doctor (at Santa Anita).

**Beverly Krueger and Betty Keller**—blacksmiths.

**Ed Kinney and Tom Gothro**—partners in a Body Shop.

**Patricia Leight**—works at Illuminating Co.

**Sonia Taylor** is one.

**Janet Hood** is one.

**Bill Bar** owns one.

**Doug Pinnow**—raises and races pigeons.

**Geraldine Socha and Nancy Wilkes**—vacationing in Denmark.

**Lambros Viores**—vacationing in Athens.

**Sharon Novak**—rides in cross-country bike races.

**Mildred Malik**—writes "Advice" column in "The News."

**Marlene Marko**—once a socialite, now the mother of triplets (Terra, Varga, and Sigma) supporting them by working as Mr. Van's upstairs maid.

**Rich Gaspar**—route man for the Press.

**Jim Hazard**—publicity agent for Berea.

**Pat and Sandy Kavelec**—still arguing about which twin has the Toni.

**Barbara Kodysh**—beautician, expert with hair rinses.

**JoAnn Koly**—runs a voice culture school.

**Jean Jenkins**—sings "Oklahoma" every Sunday in Church Choir.

**Judy Feeley**—invented an amazing new freckle remover.

**Joan Hoyer**—catches fish for a living in Huron.

July 8, 9:13 A.M. After a brief discussion, my partner and I agreed that these names we looked over the previous night, were clear of any suspicion.

9:28 A.M. The next name on the list lead us to Muscle Beach, where **Jerry Clapp**, the life-guard, was arguing with **Alan Schuerger**. Since these boys were too busy to be interrupted, we walked along the beach until we came to someone doing algebra problems in the sand. It was **Frank Soldat**. He pointed out a young man who might know something about our case. This turned out to be **Rich Caruso**, who was trying to get a sun tan. He couldn't remember a thing about the night of the prom, so we talked to a young couple building pyramids in the sand: **Vi Kovacs** and **Joe Kaczmarek**. They were too busy to be bothered also. My partner and I then questioned **Jim Steinboff**, who was building sand houses. He couldn't tell us anything we didn't know already, but suggested we talk to the "wolf" on the beach, **Bob Cieslak**. Unfortunately, he wasn't found. Our next step was to round up all the bathing beauties for questioning. They were: **LaVerne Eboosh**, **Janice Giorgione**, **Judy Goldenbogen**, **Joyce Gullford**, **Norita Hadden**, **Joyce Hess**, **Kathy Hotchkies**, **Esther Nickel**, **Carol Pinard**, **Jan Reinhart**, **Rebecca Reta**, **Barb Sliz**, **Barb Tryda**, **Dolores Vesely**, and **Sharlene Williams**. We still hadn't turned up another lead.

12:00 noon found us at Sportsman's Park

where **Sally McMullen**, **Bill Riemer**, **Tom Miller**, **John Vranic**, and **Henry Heuser** were driving in the races. **Bill Halen** was selling souvenirs and **Bob Lafeld** was found selling programs. After talking to them, my partner and I came up with a result of nothing once more.

12:31 P.M. Over a cup of coffee, we looked at the list again, and found a large part of the class had ended up at **Barb Torbak's** Home for Wayward Boys. They were: **Tom Black**, **Jim Fabris**, **Ken Lane**, **Fred Lower**, **Jim Martin**, **Bob McLaughlin**, **Tom Nielson**, **Lester Rossell**, **Dan Sadowsky**, **Dick Safran**, **Paul Scharschmidt**, **Dave Schroeder**, **Ray Sekerak**, **Dick Simpson**, and **Don Zielski**. Barb was doing a good job with these boys by giving them piano lessons. They were all clear.

Another large group of the class was in a Salvation Army Band: **Jim and Bill Setny**, **Yolanda Abranyi**, **Pete Blackford**, **Arlene and Audrey Bormann**, **Marge Dacek**, **Diane Dzurik**, **Marlene Keltner**, **Allan Okeson**, **Joe Popchak**, **Joe Schreiber**, and they had a vocalist with them named **Marlene Metro**.

Five had jobs with Dupont, in their labs, trying to get reactions: **Clarence Cernik**, **Sherman Clevenger**, **Nestor Clough**, **Alan Fassinger**, and **Roger Wicker**.

The rest of the class worked in **Jim Dick's** Gambling Casino in Las Vegas. **Marian Hosmer** was the hostess; **Christine Bargtel**, the cigarette girl; **Pat Rice**, a card deck marker; **Becky Sahley**, a bookie; **Mary Ellen Vey**, bar maid; **Chad Wachs**, bouncer; **John Gerding**, regular customer; and these girls were in the floor show: **Betty Fien**, **Carol Fogl**, **Nadine Kail**, **Edna Klaehn**, **Joy Marshall**, **Corinne Mueller**, **Joyce Pindroh**, **Mary Lou Porter**, **Shirley Schmidt**, **Gay Shaffer**, **Pat Sllwa**, **Joyce Speiser**, **Genevieve Szuba**, **Gay Thatcher**, **Maxine Ushek**, **Alberta Vaihke**, **Barb Vourliotou**, **Barb Weber**, and **Stephanie Zajac**.

Somehow my partner and I knew it was hopeless to question all these people. It looked like we lost the case. But wait! We overlooked one name. It was **Nancy Noble**. The only information we had on her was that she was attending Ohio University. 1:13 P.M. It wasn't too late to drive down there. We arrived at 6:57 P.M. It didn't take long to locate Nancy. After an hour of interrogation, she broke down and admitted she started "Slush Talk" ten years ago at J.F.R. However, she now had a good job as head caddy on O.U.'s golf course and promised us she was going straight. She would never again utter another word in "Slush". We believed Nancy and closed the case at 8 P.M. on July 8, 1968.

Now that this bombastic episode is finished, my partner and I are retiring from the police force, and taking up permanent residence at Bellevue.

Our class officers were DON REUTENER, president; JIM STUCKEY, vice-president; and BOB BEECH, treasurer. PHYLLIS KUBIT and her social committee consisting of RON ELCHESEN, RICHARD BROWN, RICHARD GASPAR, JEAN JENKINS, MARLENE MARKO, JIM KOBERLING, NANCY NOBLE, PAT RICE, ALAN SCHUERGER, MARY ELLEN VEY, and ROGER WICKER, worked busily creating "A Knight in May," the theme of our 11A Informal in the Rhodes ballroom.

The National Honor Society inducted ten of our number in the 11A semester: MARY ANN CSONTOS, LESLIE JABB, GAIL KOONS, PHYLLIS KUBIT, DOUG PINNOW, DAN SADOWSKY, FRANK SOLDAT, BARBARA TORBAK, BARBARA VACHUSKA, and ROGER WICKER.

MILLY MALIK was the Alpha Queen for the Tri-High Trot.

The class was a very musical one. In addition to having forty-nine class members in the Senior Choir, BARBAR SLIZ, DIANE ABOID, CARL HENNINGER, RICHARD LUKASH, ROBERT BEECH, RICHARD GASPAR, and JOHN GRAFTON were the class's representatives in the All-City Choir.

It seems that D.D.T. has just run out of items! He appeals to the crowd for donations, since we are only \$9.08 short of our goal.


