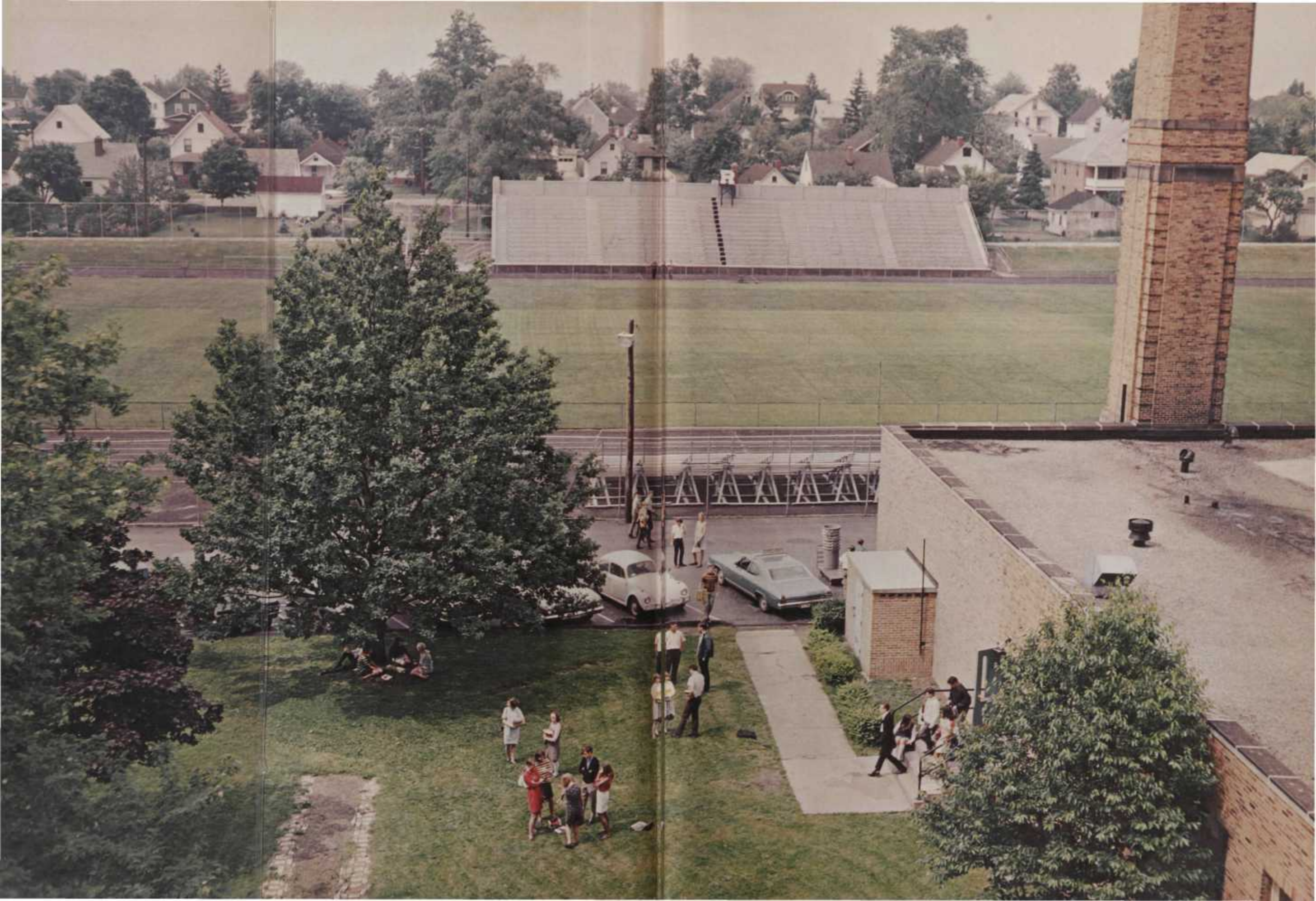

Well, seniors, you are strong enough to do it. We are confident you will find a way to live useful lives during which you will find a way to provide service needed by others.

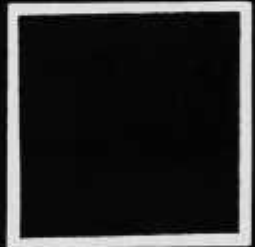
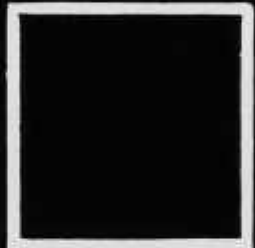
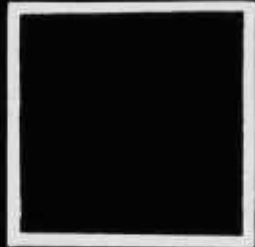
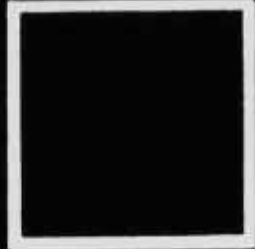
