son when Don Gallagher returned a kickoff 75 yards for a touchdown. The Rams closed out the season with losses to John Marshall and St. Ignatius.

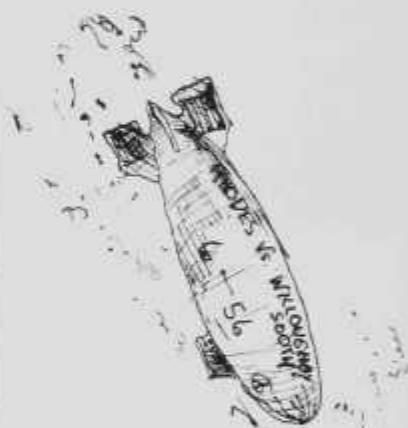

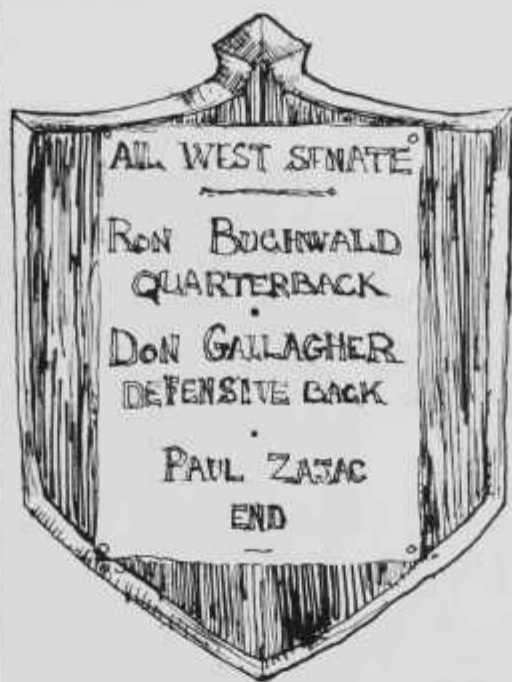

# Rams Play Frustrating Season

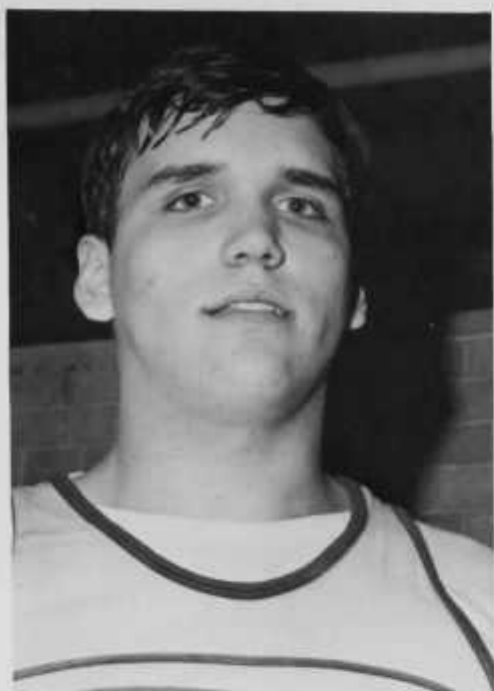

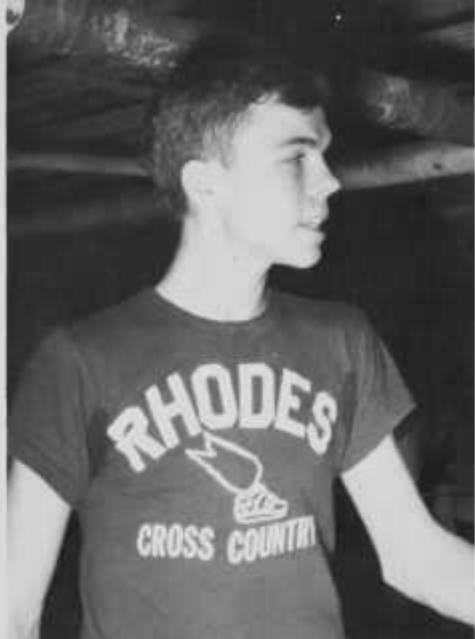

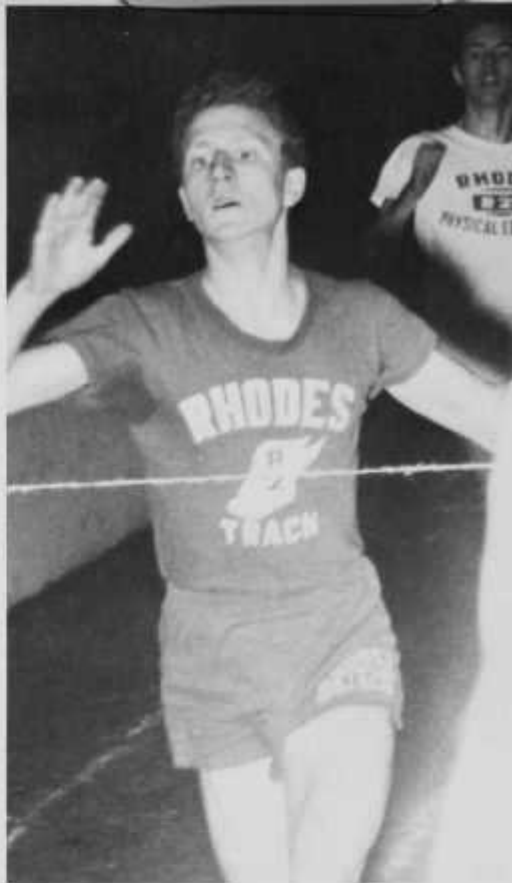
