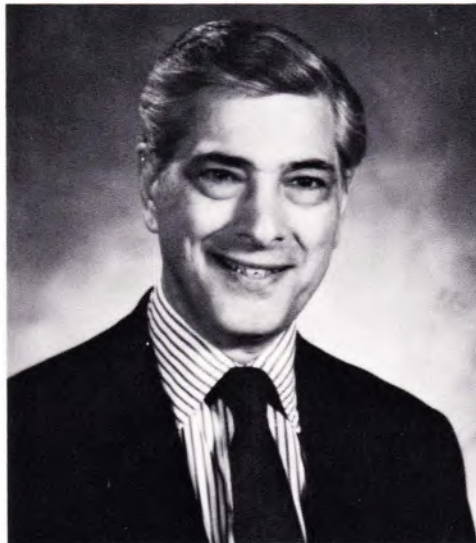

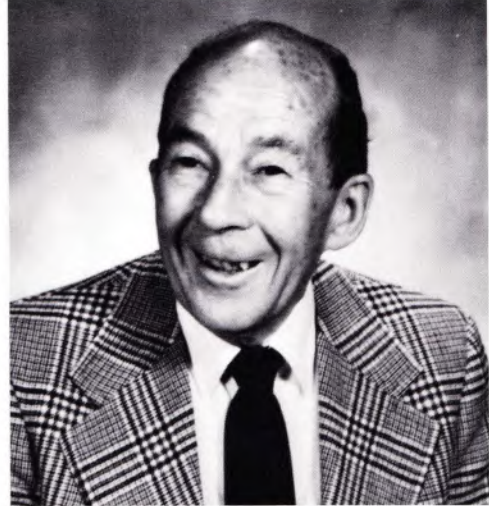

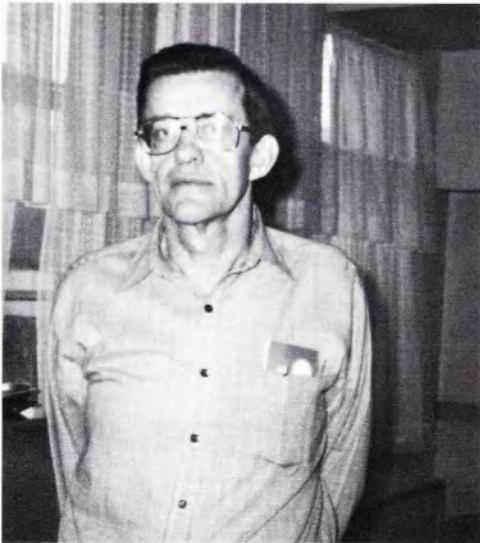

I wish you success in your future endeavors. Good luck and best wishes.

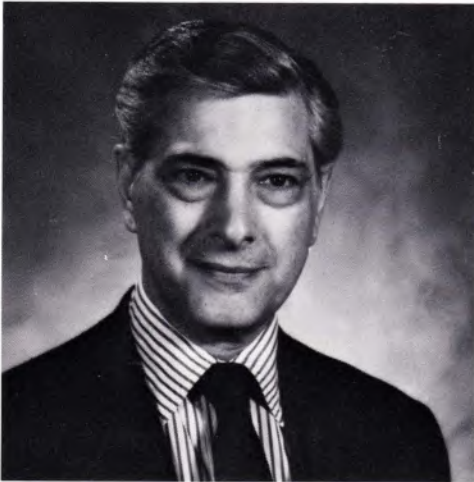

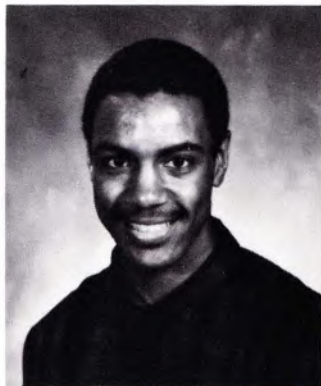
Rhodes has seen many seniors come and go, but I don't think it has seen a class like the Class of 1987.
