

User Manual for The B.A.N.G. Jubilee Calculator

Purpose of the Tool

The B.A.N.G. Jubilee Calculator is designed to help users visualize and calculate specific years within a Jubilee cycle according to the **SJF 3rd Method**. This method is rooted in biblical chronology, where each Jubilee spans **50 years**, divided into **7 weeks of 7 years**, followed by a celebratory year.

How to Use the Calculator



1. Input the Jubilee Cycle Number


- What to enter: Any Jubilee between 1 to 120.
- What it means: Each Jubilee represents a 50 year span of time.
- **Example**: Entering 106 refers to the 106th Jubilee cycle of 49 weeks of years, and the year of Jubilee which is the 50th Year..


Enter Complete Weeks

- What to enter: A number from 0 to 7.
- What it means: Each week is 7 years. This input allows you to skip full 7-year periods within the Jubilee cycle.
- **Example**: 3 means you're skipping 21 years into the Jubilee cycle.




3. Enter Additional Years

- What to enter: A number from 0 to 7.
- What it means: These are the extra years within the current week.
- **Example**: Entering 2 means you're in the 2nd year of the current week.



4. Click "Calculate"

- The calculator will display a detailed breakdown of your inputs and the final calculated year in the cycle.
- You'll also see a full 49-year grid showing which year you landed on.



III Visual Guide: Understanding the Calendar Display

Color

Meaning

Green

First year of the Jubilee cycle



Red

Final sabbatical year (49th year)



Yellow

The specific year you calculated



Gray

All other years in the cycle

• The calendar is divided into 7 rows (weeks)



- And 7 columns (years in each week).
- Helps visualize your position in a 49-year cycle.



What the Tool Calculates

- @ Target Year in the 50-year Jubilee structure
- The first year of the selected Jubilee cycle

"Your Jubilee Year Revealed"

Purpose of the Tool

This tool calculates:

- The Jubilee Cycle for any given AD year.
- The corresponding AM year (Anno Mundi, "year of the world").
- The first year, final sabbatical year, and celebratory Jubilee year within that cycle.
- A calendar-style visualization of the 49-year Jubilee cycle, with the input year highlighted.




X How to Use the Calculator

1. Enter Any AD Year

• In the input field labeled:


"Enter Any AD Year:"


• Type any valid AD year (e.g., 1865, 70, 2025).




2. Click the "Calculate" Button

- Triggers the calculator to compute:
 - Jubilee cycle number
 - First year of the cycle
 - Final sabbatical year (49th)
 - Jubilee celebratory year (50th)
 - AM year (AD + 3421)








3. View the Results

The results will include:

- 13 The Jubilee Cycle number
- W The first year of that cycle (in both AM and AD)
- The **final sabbatical year** (49th year)
- The **Jubilee celebratory year** (50th year)
- Your entered AD year is highlighted in the 49-year cycle grid



Calendar Grid Display

Color Meaning Green 1st year of the Jubilee cycle Red 49th year – sabbatical year Yellow The AD year you entered Gray Other years in the cycle

- Layout: 7x7 grid = 49 years = 7 weeks of 7 years
- Helps visualize where your AD year falls in Jubilee History
