Before You Begin - Eligibility Requirements

- ✓ Language Background
 - Primary language is Spanish
 - Came to the USA and transitioned to English OR recently learned English
 - Comfortable reading and understanding both Spanish and English
- ✓ Exam History
 - Have taken the TDLR Journeyman Electrician Exam at least once
 - Did not pass on previous attempt(s)
 - Have official TDLR test results available
- ✓ Geographic Requirement
 - Currently live in a border town in the Rio Grande Valley, Texas
- ✓ Computer and Internet Setup
 - Have reliable computer/device and internet connection
 - Meet system requirements (see separate document)
 - Can upload and download documents

Course & Beta-Testing Outline

Step 1: Document Submission

- Deadline: Must complete within 3 days of acceptance
- ✓ ☐ IRB Participant Form
 - Download from beta tester portal
 - Read carefully and choose to participate or decline research
 - Sign and date the form
 - Upload completed form
- ✓ Non-Disclosure Agreement (NDA)
 - Download NDA document
 - Read agreement thoroughly
 - Sign with your legal name
 - Upload signed document
- ✓ TDLR Exam Results
 - Submit your most recent Journeyman Electrician Exam results
 - Must be official TDLR documentation
 - If you don't have results, call TDLR at (512) 463-6599
 - Upload clear, readable copy

Step 2: Course Completion

- Deadline: Must complete entire course within 1 month (30 days)
- ✓ Week 1 Goals
 - Complete course introduction and first 3 modules
 - Submit any technical issues to support team
 - Begin taking detailed notes for feedback
- ✓ Week 2 Goals
 - Complete modules 4-6
 - Participate in all interactive exercises
 - Document any confusing content or language issues
- ✓ Week 3 Goals
 - Complete modules 7-9
 - Take all practice exams
 - Note any areas needing improvement
- ✓ Week 4 Goals
 - Complete final modules and review materials
 - Take final practice exam
 - Complete quality feedback form
- ✓ Track Your Progress
 - Log study hours each week
 - Note which lessons were most/least helpful
 - Document any technical problems
 - Keep record of questions that were confusing

Step 3: Quality Feedback

- Deadline: Must complete within 3 days of finishing course
- ✓ Complete Detailed Feedback Form
 - Rate overall course effectiveness (1-10 scale)
 - Identify most helpful lessons
 - List lessons that need improvement

- Comment on language clarity (English/Spanish)
- Suggest additional content needed
- Report any technical issues
- Recommend changes for future students
- ✓ Provide Specific Examples
 - Screenshot confusing sections
 - Note exact locations of problems
 - Suggest better explanations or translations
 - Identify missing content areas

Step 4: Take Official Journeyman Exam

- Deadline: Must take exam minimum 2 weeks after course completion
- ✓ Schedule Your Exam
 - Register with TDLR for Journeyman Electrician Exam
 - Schedule exam date at least 2 weeks after course completion
 - Confirm exam location and requirements
- ✓ Prepare for Exam
 - Review course materials
 - Use course practice tests
 - Study areas identified as weak points
- ✓ Take the Exam
 - Arrive prepared with required identification
 - Take exam seriously - this data helps improve our course
 - Use strategies learned in the course

Step 5: Submit Final Results

- Deadline: Must submit within 1 week of taking exam
- ✓ Official Exam Results
 - Obtain official TDLR exam results
 - Submit pass/fail status
 - Include score breakdown if available
 - Upload official documentation
- ✓ Final Feedback Survey
 - Complete post-exam feedback form
 - Compare course training to actual exam
 - Identify what was most helpful for exam success
 - Suggest improvements based on exam experience

Important Reminders

✓ Timeline Summary

- Documents: 3 days after acceptance
- Course completion: 30 days maximum
- Quality feedback: 3 days after course completion
- Take exam: Minimum 2 weeks after course, maximum 6 weeks
- Submit results: Within 1 week of taking exam

✓ Communication Requirements

- Check email daily for updates
- Respond to support team within 24 hours
- Report technical issues immediately
- Attend virtual check-in meeting (if scheduled)

✓ Confidentiality

- Do not share course materials with anyone
- Do not discuss course content on social media
- Keep all training materials private per NDA
- Report any violations of confidentiality
